


Customize customer, vendor and item fields in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central without development

Automatic field propagation

Once setup is complete, all selected fields will be available in Customer, Item and Vendor cards into the Additional Information FastTab. All can be used as regular fields, e.g. posting a sales order will propagate information to a shipment and invoice.
